Most people would consider an 8-4 win a most satisfactory result but Suffolk were hoping for a greater winning margin in order to keep up maximum preassure on their arch rivals for the championship title,Essex,who had no game at the week-end.

Wayne Squirrell (Bacton).got the home side off to a good start with a 2-1 win in the opener.Middlesex replied with a win in the second to square matters,but wins from Garry Prime (Hadleigh),Dean Barker and Kelvin Self saw Suffolk go into the interval 4-2 up.

The girls,currently enjoying their best season ever,notched their fourth win of the season taking all three games with wins from belinda Golding and Kay Clarke (Ipswich),and Sharon Potkins (Melton) who took the Lady of the Match award.

Samuel Naxton (Haverhill),opened the second half proceedings for the boys with a fine 2-1 win,making the score 5-2-to Suffolk.

Scott Annet took the eighth game for Middlesex winning him the Man of the Match award with a fine 22-77 average

A 2-1 win from Wayne Barkerin the ninth,ensured the home side a share of the spoils,but the very next game saw the points "IN THE BAG" as Gerald Warner produced a very workmanlike 2-1 win in 23 and 24 darts (21-32).

Highlight of the afternoon was a brilliant 2-0 win on the eleventh from Matthew Alexander (Ipswich),who stole the show and the Man of the Match Award for Suffolk with his sparkling 28-63 average from 16 and 19 dart legs.

Middlesex won the final game,but not without a tremendous battle from Kevin Harris who won the first leg in 19 darts and notched up a 180 in the second which he was most unfortunate not to win in 14 darts.His opponant seized his chance after Kevin failed to double out and took the leg in 16 darts,then went on to win the third.
