TEMS FROM THE B.D.O. COUNCIL MEETING - APRIL 22ND 1990

The 1990 British Youth Championships will be televised on BBC2 between the 30th of April and the 4th of May. Sadly though, due to the lack of interest shown by the majority of the Counties, it is not scheduled to stage this event in 1991. The young players of today are the lifeblood of the game in the future so this decision, though in the light of statistics given is understandable though very regrettable. London would like to acknowledge the tremendous job done by John Day (Buckinghamshire) in his organisation of the Southern Inter-Counties Youth League, a vital stepping stone to major Inter-County Darts.

The London area regional final of the Websters 150 Championship will be held at this venue, the East Ham W.M.C. on Saturday 9th June 1990 starting at 1pm. Our best wishes are extended to two London players who have qualified, Tommy Wilson and Paul Doggett.

The John Bull 'Cockney Classic' Regional Play-Off's are scheduled between the 3rd and 13th September 1990, with the finals on the 9th and 10th October.

The very popular Seashore Festival of Darts, in Great Yarmouth, between the 28th of September and 2nd of October requires uniformed county officials. If you would like to take up the option of free accommodation please write directly to the B.D.O. Headquarters or contact the London General Secretary.

Dart players will be making a welcome return to two previous 'Haunts' following the closure of the Rainbow Suite in Kensington. The World Masters, 7th and 8th of December, will be staged at the Ramada Inn, Lillie Road, West London, formerly the West Centre Hotel, and the British Open will be returning to the Horticultural Halls, Victoria on the 28th and 29th December 1990.
