The young players of today are the lifeblood of the game in the future so this decision, though in the light of statistics given is understandable though very regrettable. London would like to acknowledge the tremendous job done by John Day (Buckinghamshire) in his organisation of the Southern Inter-Counties Youth League, a vital stepping stone to major Inter-County Darts.
